New Roles

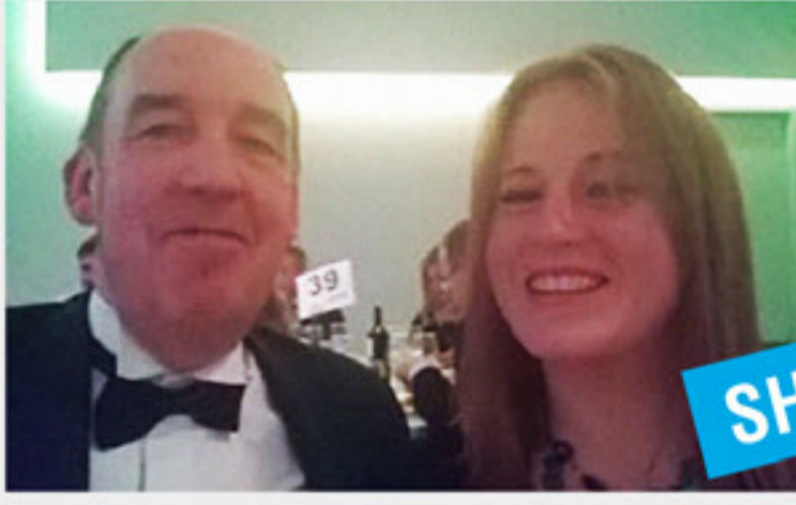
