

Head to Toe: Why wear safety gloves?



The human hand is remarkable.

Capable of a vast range of different functions, we use our hands all the time to **communicate**, **detect texture** and **temperature**, to **identify** form, **grip** or **grasp** anything from the tiniest speck to heavy loads and to make a multitude of other complex movements needed in our everyday lives.

The hand is a **supremely important tool** that most of us take for granted, and as so often happens, we don't realise what we have until we lose it.



In 2017, around **117,000 workers** every day suffered handling-related injuries, many of which directly affected the hand. From temporary problems to permanent loss of fingers, function or even the whole hand, the effects can be immense.



There are **27 BONES**, **29 JOINTS** and more than **120 LIGAMENTS** in a human hand.

Fingers have **NO MUSCLES**: it is the muscles in the forearm which move **TENDONS** in our fingers.

A massive 25% OF YOUR BRAIN and 48

SEPARATE NERVES are involved in controlling the

COMPLEX movement and coordination of your hands!

Our fingers are even **MORE SENSITIVE** than our eyes. Human fingertips are densely packed with receptors which send **MILLIONS** of messages to the brain **EVERY DAY**.

INJURIES TO THE HAND are one of the commonest disabling workplace injuries and account for 33% of all patients visiting A&E.

Your hands are precious... protect them!

For those in the construction industry, healthy hands are crucial to maintaining your livelihood so it's vital to safeguard them.

Without the protection of appropriate safety gloves, serious gashes, puncture wounds, electrical shocks, damage from water, oils, chemical or biological agents, extreme temperatures, excessive vibration and major traumas such as the loss of fingers or even the hands themselves can all happen - in the blink of an eye.

MAKE SURE you have the right PPE gloves for the job, and replace them if they become damaged or worn.


