RGS MD Emma Lewis said,

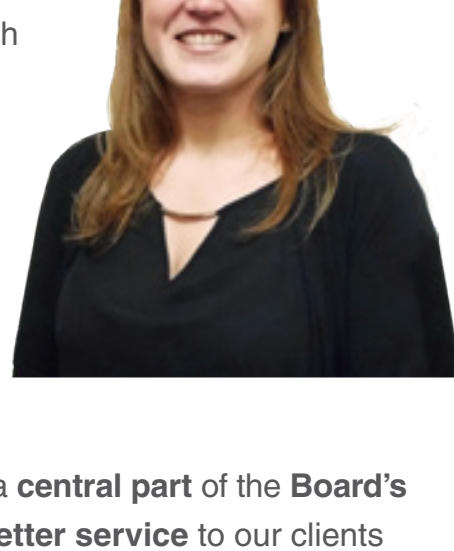
“ RGS has come a long way since 2004 and has overcome a number of challenges, including global recession which hit the construction industry particularly hard.

We will be profiling our new team members in the coming months but we are starting with Katie Wallett, in 'Hello Katie', below.



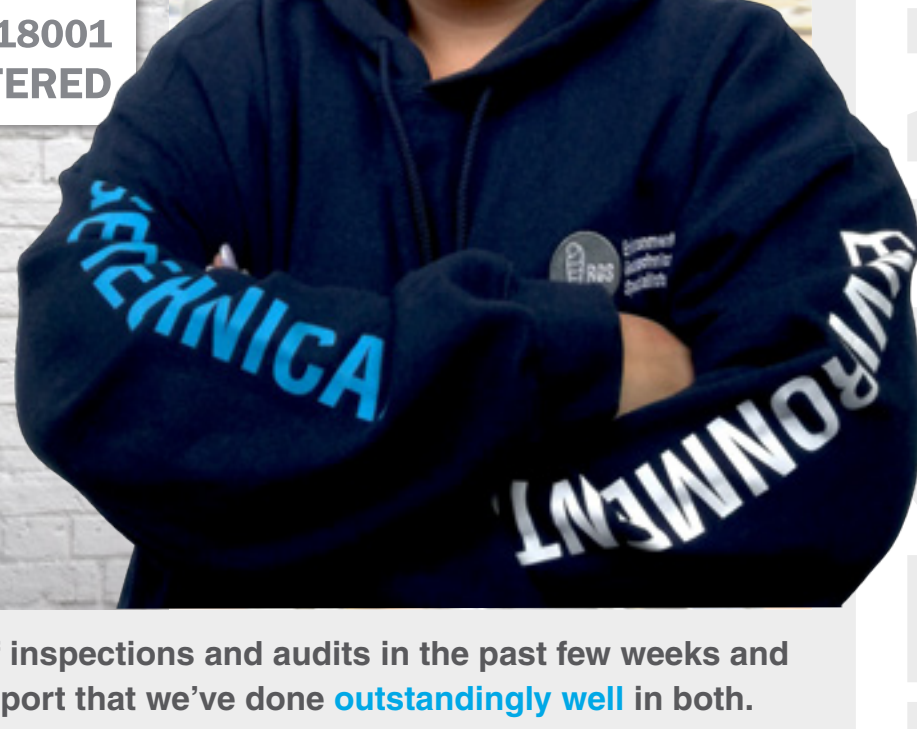
